

## Northwest, North Carolina

Northwest is a city in Brunswick County, North Carolina, United States. The population was 671 at the 2000 census. DemographicsAs of the censusGR2 of 2000, there were 671 people, 260 households, and 185 families residing in the city. The population density was 42.2/km<sup>2</sup> (109.2/mi<sup>2</sup>). There were 293 housing units at an average density of 18.4/km<sup>2</sup> (47.7/mi<sup>2</sup>). The racial makeup of the city was 26.83% White, 71.83% African American, 0.45% Native American, 0.30% Asian, 0.15% from other races, and 0.45% from two or more races. Hispanic or Latino of any race were 0.75% of the population. There were 260 households out of which 32.3% had children under the age of 18 living with them, 48.5% were married couples living together, 18.5% had a female householder with no husband present, and 28.5% were non-families. 24.2% of all households were made up of individuals and 8.5% had someone living alone who was 65 years of age or older. The average household size was 2.58 and the average family size was 3.07. In the city the population was spread out with 26.7% under the age of 18, 5.5% from 18 to 24, 27.9% from 25 to 44, 27.0% from 45 to 64, and 13.0% who were 65 years of age or older. The median age was 40 years. For every 100 females there were 79.4 males. For every 100 females age 18 and over, there were 80.9 males. The median income for a household in the city was \$31,250, and the median income for a family was \$37,500. Males had a median income of \$29,821 versus \$19,479 for females. The per capita income for the city was \$16,419. About 14.0% of families and 17.6% of the population were below the poverty line, including 21.8% of those under age 18 and 15.6% of those age 65 or over. GeographyNorthwest is located at 34°18′N, 78°9′W (34.309517, -78.152817)GR1. According to the United States Census Bureau, the city has a total area of 15.9 km<sup>2</sup> (6.1 mi<sup>2</sup>), all land.
